Parking Concerns As We Move Into Summer

Now that the construction has started and the fencing has gone up around parking lots 207 and 208, the parking situation in lot 206 in front of the faculty club has changed as well.

Muir College Drive no longer connects with Muir Lane to provide access to the club. To get to the Faculty Club, turn east onto La Jolla Shores drive and then take a left turn onto Scholars Drive. Scholars Drive will turn into Muir Lane and lead directly to parking lot 206 where the Faculty Club is located. This will be the only way to access the club during the duration of the construction.

The Faculty Club still controls the fifty marked parking spaces directly in front of the club. The balance of the "A" Permit spaces in the lot have changed. There are now 3 Hour limits on some "A" Permit spots, mostly along the western edge of the parking lot. There are twelve 3 Hour "B" Permit spots next to the Faculty Club spots. About half of the overall "A" Permit spots have not changed and do not have a time limitation.

Anytime from July 23 to August 10, there will be fencing going up that will possibly take the two parking lanes along the western edge of lot 206 out of use for a limited time. There will be construction trailers being put on the grass as well as construction of a new walking path along the edge of lot 206 to Muir Lane.

We thank you all for your understanding during the construction and we will continue to keep our members informed of any changes to the parking in front of the club.

RIDGE VINEYARDS AND NAVARRO VINEYARDS ARE THE FEATURED WINERIES FOR THE MONTH OF JULY





Ridge Vineyards East Bench Zinfandel will be our red wine of the month for July. This wine is 100% zinfandel grapes from the Dry Creek Valley. The wine has blackberry, cocoa, and licorice on the nose. It is full bodied with a palate of fig and plum fruit, chalky tannins, mineral and chaparral notes on the finish.

Our white wine for the month of July is the Navarro Vineyards Riesling. The Riesling is produced in the Anderson Valley. It is a dry, light-bodied but not wimpy Riesling. This crisp wine has a great structure built from acidity and plenty of Granny Smith apple and white peach flavors that keep it interesting. A touch of ripeness on the palate rounds out the texture and helps give it a lingering finish.

Join us in Cecil's Lounge where you can sample this month's wines. Three ounce samples of both wines are \$10, a full glass of either wine is \$12.50, or a bottle of either wine is \$50. See you at Cecil's on Wednesday and Thursday throughout the month of July.
