



SUSPENSION OF MEMBERSHIP DUES TO CONTINUE

UPDATED BYLAWS PASSED BY BOARD

Although the Club is closed, the Board continues to work from a variety of remote locations. In accordance with the Affiliation Agreement, signed in August 2019 by the Club and the university, the Club bylaws have been updated and will soon be posted to the Club's website.

PERMISSION FOR ELECTRONIC VOTING

The annual election of members to the Faculty Club's Board of Directors is forthcoming later this month. In order to electronically conduct the official business of the Faculty Club, California law (Corporations Code sections 20 and 21) requires voting Members to consent to electronic communications. The Faculty Club has traditionally sent notice of elections via email, and Members have voted through secure electronic means. To be compliant with the law, the Club needs to have your consent to this process. In addition, the law requires the Club to tell you that you may revoke this consent at any time.

While the law seems anachronistic these days, it none the less needs to be followed. Please reply to this email stating that you consent to receiving and sending notices via email and voting by secure electronic means.

If you do not reply by 5:00 pm, 8 May 2020, it will be assumed you so consent. All consents will be noted for the record.
